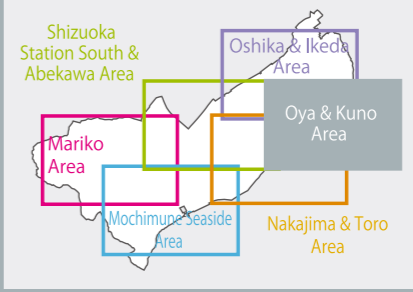

Museum of Natural and Environmental History, Shizuoka
