



Regarding 2023 Autumn-Start Covid-19 Vaccinations (For Infants)

新型コロナウイルスワクチン令和5年秋開始接種について【乳幼児向け】

Persons aged 6 months to 4 years are eligible for infant vaccinations.

- The vaccine used is a monovalent vaccine for infants, targeting the Omicron XBB.1.5 variant.
- The shot is available once at least 3 months have passed since your infant's last (3rd) shot.
Please confirm yourself whether 3 months have passed since the last shot.

How to Make a Reservation

Scan the QR Code for a list of medical institutions that are carrying out vaccinations (*Japanese), and make a reservation directly with a medical institution.

When Receiving the Shot After Turning 5

- ① As you no longer fall into the age range (6months to 4 years), you are no longer eligible for shots of the infant vaccine.
- ② Scan the QR code for a list of facilities administering the child vaccine (ages 5 to 11) and make a reservation.

Check before making a reservation!

Regarding interval between other vaccinations:

The Covid-19 vaccination can be received at the same time as the influenza vaccine. (Other vaccines cannot be received at the same time, so please wait 2 weeks between different vaccinations.)

What to Bring on the Day:

Vaccination is not possible without these, so please be careful.

- **Vaccination ticket and pre-vaccination screening questionnaire**
(These are sent joined together, so please bring them without separating)
- **Personal identification document**
(My Number Card, Health Insurance Certificate, Residence Card, etc.)
- **Maternal and Child Health Handbook (母子手帳, *boshi techo*)**
- **Medication Record Book (おくすり手帳, *okusuri techo*)**
(Only if you are taking medication)

Parental consent and accompaniment are required for vaccination.

Parents, please make sure to accompany your child to their vaccination.

Important Points for the Day of Your Vaccination

Before vaccination

- Please wear clothes that provide easy access to your shoulder and upper arm.
- Please cancel your reservation if you are obviously unwell (fever, etc.).

After vaccination

- Everyday activities should not be a problem but please avoid intense exercise.
- Please keep the injection site clean
- Bathing should not be a problem but please do not rub the injection site intensely.

Regarding Vaccination Tickets of Those Who Were Unable to Get Vaccinated Due to Doctor's Decision

If, on the day of vaccination, the doctor decided your child was unable to be vaccinated, and you would like to receive new vaccination tickets (*sesshuken*, 接種券), you will need to apply for reissuance.
