## What is the Shizuoka City Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu?



Nurturing children's sense of autonomy, community, and creativity through free play, self-study, interesting activities, and interaction with both members of the local community and children from other grades.

It is a social education program that uses the school facilities to provide a safe place for children after school.

The program is run with help from members of the community.

The aim is to create an environment where everyone in the community helps to raise children.







## Organizer and Operating bodies:

Organizer Shizuoka City Board of Education **Operating Bodies** 

Executive committees made up of parents and community members from each school zone.



## Participation:

⟨Eligible children⟩

- · All students attending Elementary schools that have this program (Grade 1 -6)
- \*Enrollment is necessary.
- \*There is no limit on the number of members and children can participate regardless of their parents' work status.
- \*Some schools may limit the grades that can attend due to facility restraints, countermeasures for infectious diseases, etc.

(Children who cannot attend)

- · Children who haven't been enrolled
- · Children who have already gone home once after school
- · Children who are unwell, have a person close to them with an infectious disease, or other situations that call for infectious disease countermeasures.
- · Children whose behavior interferes with the safety of others, are unable to obey the instructions of the staff, etc.



#### Days and Time:

- · On school days, as determined by each executive committee.
- · From the end of lessons until the final leaving time determined by each school.
- \* For detailed times, dates and contents of activities, see the newsletter, etc. of your child's *Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu*.



#### Fees:

Generally free. \*Fees for craft supplies and insurance fees may be necessary.



## Insurance

- · In general, PTA activity insurance, or the insurance plan of each *Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu* will be applied. Insurance coverage differs by school, so please confirm with your school. Those seeking additional coverage must please enroll in an insurance plan individually.
- · Injuries incurred outside of *Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu* activities or through deliberate, seriously dangerous behavior, etc. are not covered.

# **How to Enroll**

In order to attend, it is <u>necessary to enroll beforehand</u>. Please submit the enrollment form through your child's school at the beginning of each school year.

### **Enrollment Procedure.**

- 1. Enrollment forms will be distributed through your child's school at the beginning of each school year
- 2. Please fill in the necessary information and submit the form to your school.
- 3. The form will be kept at the Shizuoka City Board of Education for one year.
  - \* For emergency contacts, please write **numbers where the people can actually be contacted** in an emergency.
  - ◆ It is possible to enroll part way through the school year. Please contact the *Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu* at your child's school.

# Responding in an Emergency / When a Child is Injured.



## Injury, Poor Health, Underlying Conditions, Previous Illnesses

- · Every precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of the children. However, in the event of injury or sudden illness during the activities, we ask parents to come and collect your child.
- · Depending on the extent of the injury/illness, parents may be contacted after the child has been taken to hospital.
  - \*For emergency contacts, please include a number where the person can actually be contacted in an emergency, such as a cellphone number, or work number.
  - \*Staff at Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu are not able to give medical treatment (including administering medication). Parents of children with underlying conditions or previous illnesses must please keep this in mind when enrolling and allowing your child to attend.
  - \*There is no resting area at Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu



## When visiting a healthcare facility for injuries sustained at <u>Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu</u>

- As Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu activities do not fall under school administration, treatment for injuries sustained during these activities qualifies for benefits under the "Shizuoka Shi Kodomo Iryohi Josei Seido" (Shizuoka City Children's Medical Fees Subsidy System). In the unlikely event of a hospital visit, please use your "Kodomo Iryo Jukyūsha Sho" (Child Medical Treatment Recipient Card).
- ♠ In addition to the above, parents wanting to use the designated insurance for Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu should contact the Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu at their child's school. Children who have completed the enrollment procedure and are participating on the day in question after "signing in" are eligible for coverage under the designated insurance for Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu.



## Response in emergencies such as disaster warnings, etc.

- The procedure for children leaving school in the event of natural disasters such as typhoons, earthquakes, etc. will be based on the emergency guidelines set out by each school.
- · Children from classes or grades that have been temporarily closed due to infectious diseases, etc. may not participate.

  Also, please note that, depending on the situation, activities may be cancelled altogether.

# **Procedure When Attending**

If your child has been enrolled, they are free to attend on any of the activity days.

When attending, always make sure to go through the "sign-in" procedure run by the school.

# [Let's Take Part in Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu Activities!]

## **〈Before Attending〉**

Talk to your parents beforehand and decide if you will attend on a given day, and at what time you will come home.

Some Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu require an "attendance card", etc.

# **(When Attending)**

- ① After final greetings in the classroom, come with your school bag to the *Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu.\*Jido* Club members should listen to the instructions of the *Jido* Club Supporter.
- ② Greet and "sign in". The "sign-in" procedure is different for each school. Listen to the staff.
- 3 Pack your schoolbag away and enjoy the activities with your friends.

## **⟨When it's Time to Go Home⟩**

- 1 Talk to the staff and "sign out".
- Make sure you have all your belongings, greet the staff, and head home.

# **Requests When Attending**

- This program does not provide tutoring or guidance to students.
- This program is made possible through the support of community staff members. Please greet the staff and talk to them in a way that shows your gratitude.
- Please tell your child to behave in a way that doesn't interfere with other children's enjoyment of the activities.
- The staff are not able to give messages or instructions to children regarding the time to go home. Please decide these details clearly with your family before you attend.

# Let's all follow the rules and enjoy the Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu together!



# How to Fill In the Enrollment Form.

In the past, children who are not enrolled have shown up to the *Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu* because they were "invited by a friend". For this reason we recommend that all students enroll at the beginning of the school year. If you enroll once, you are free to attend at any time during the year. All enrollment forms are kept together by the Board of Education and emergency contact information is provided to the *Hokago Kodomo Kyoshitsu* staff in the event of an emergency.
