

## What happens if the National Health Insurance Premium is not paid?



Be Careful!

If payments in arrears are not paid, the following measures will be taken!



◎ Investigation of property (inquiries will be conducted at your place of employment, with your business partners, financial institutions, etc.)

In the event that there is no response despite receiving a written notice, and your insurance premiums in arrears remain unpaid, an investigation of property will be conducted for failure to pay taxes (for the seizure of property, etc.) at your place of employment, business partners, financial institutions, etc. in accordance with laws and regulations.

◎Disposition for Tax Delinquency (for the seizure of property, etc.)

If it is not paid even after the investigation of your property has been conducted, measures will be taken for tax delinquency (seizure of property, etc.) according to laws and regulations.

◎Qualification Certificate (the insured will be required to pay the full medical expense)

If the insurance premiums are not paid despite lack of special circumstances, you will be required to return your National Health Insurance Card and a Qualification Certificate will be given to you instead (a health insurance card in which all medical expenses must be paid by the insured).

※Receiving the Qualification Certificate does not eliminate your obligation to pay the premiums in arrears. In addition, measures against tax delinquency (seizure of property, etc.) will also be taken.

Payment method for National Health Insurance Premium

- Bank Transfer (please apply at the financial institution listed on the payment form.)
- Payment Form (pay at any financial institution, convenience store, “mobile reji” and “mobile reji credit” payment app systems for smartphones.)
