Access

(JR)

Take the train from Shizuoka Station to Shimizu Station (approx.13 mins.) From Shimizu Station, take the bus to Miho no Matsubara (approx. 25 mins.) Get off at "Miho no Matsubara Iriguchi" and walk approx.15 mins. *

[Shizutetsu Line]

Take the bus to Miho no Matsubara form Shin-Shimizu Station (approx. 20 mins.) Get off at "Miho no Matsubara Iriguchi" and walk approx.15 mins. **On weekends and public holidays, buses run directly to the destination "Sekai Isan Miho no Matsubara" bus stop.

It is a 5 min. walk from the "Sekai Isan Miho no Matsubara" bus stop. [Car]

Approx. 25 mins. from Shimizu IC; Approx. 35 mins. from Shizuoka IC Approx. 25 mins. from Nihondaira Kunozan Smart IC (173 car parks available)
