Origins

Shizuoka City Miho no Matsubara Culture & Creativity Center "Miho Shirube" is a facility dedicated to spreading information both domestically and internationally about the fascinating place that Miho no Matsubara is; its magnificent view of Mt. Fuji with the Matsubara pine grove, its significant cultural value, notably the Legend of Hagaromo and also the diverse forms of art such as Ukiyoe and Waka that it inspired. It also aims to bring to light the efforts made by the locals to preserve the pine grove.

Take the train from Shizuoka Station to Shimizu Station (approx. 13 mins.)
From Shimizu Station, take the bus to Miho no Matsubara (approx. 25 mins.)
Get off at "Miho no Matsubara Iriguchi" and walk approx. 15 mins. ※

[Shizutetsu Line]

Take the bus to Miho no Matsubara from Shin-Shimizu Station (approx. 20 mins.)
Get off at "Miho no Matsubara Iriguchi" and walk approx. 15 mins. ※
※On weekends and public holidays, buses run directly to the destination "Sekai Isan Miho no Matsubara" bus stop.
It is a 5 min. walk from the "Sekai Isan Miho no Matsubara" bus stop.

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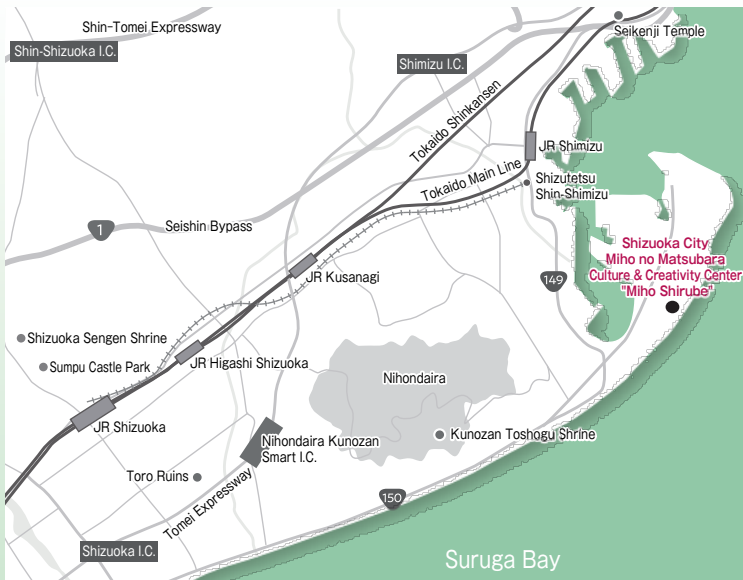

Exhibition Area

Invitation to Miho no Matsubara

The hallway leading to the exhibition room welcomes visitors as a gate into a mystical world, with hagoromo kimonos swaying amid the scent of pine.



This exhibition area introduces the importance and charms of Miho no Matsubara (pine grove). You will find everything there is to know on the Hagoromo legend and diverse works of art. A full-scale replica of the "Fuji Mandala painted on silk" is also displayed here. ※ Taking pictures is prohibited in the 1F exhibition area.



Earthen-floor hallway

This hallway connects the center with Miho no Matsubara (the pine grove). A series of Ukiyoe posters featuring Miho no Matsubara are on permanent display here. Pictures, etc. are also on display at special exhibitions. You can take a break here as you sip a drink or savor a snack bought at the museum shop.



Exhibition Area
(Preservation and Local History)

An exhibition on the preservation of the pine grove and history of the Miho area can be seen here.



You will find a variety of pinecones, the flora that inhabits the pine grove as well as an opportunity to try musical instruments made from the pine tree. Documents and books about Miho are also available here.



Civic Activity Space

An area where individuals and organizations dedicated to the preservation and utilization of Miho no Matsubara can share information and interact.
