



# Let's Be Prepared for a Tsunami



The **Shizuoka Prefecture Disaster Prevention App** is available in English and allows you to check expected tsunami inundation areas as well as the location of evacuation sites and centers.

The best thing to do is get as far away from the ocean as possible, but when this is not possible, please try to get as high up as you can. In areas where evacuation from tsunamis is especially difficult, the city has erected **designated evacuation towers/buildings**.



## Suruga Ward Information

Inundation area: 410ha  
Maximum tsunami height (30m offshore): 12m  
Minimum arrival time of tsunami: 3min



## Shimizu Ward Information

Inundation area: 1,380ha  
Maximum tsunami height (30m offshore): 11m  
Minimum arrival time of tsunami: 2min

## FY2022 Tsunami Evacuation Drill

Evacuating during a tsunami is a fight against time. Please take this opportunity to confirm your evacuation area and route, so that you can evacuate safely when time is limited.



**When:** Sun 5 March 2023, from 10:00

**Timeline:** \*The contents of the drill are still tentative

**10:00** Earthquake Occurrence Drill

**10:03** Major Tsunami Warning Announcement Drill

Wireless Broadcast, Emergency Information Disaster Prevention Radio, Emergency Rapid Communication Email

## Warashina Lifelong Learning Center to be temporarily removed as an evacuation center due to closure (June 2023 to March 2024).

The center is currently designated as an “evacuation center” and a “emergency evacuation site during an earthquake” but will be temporarily removed due to renovation .
