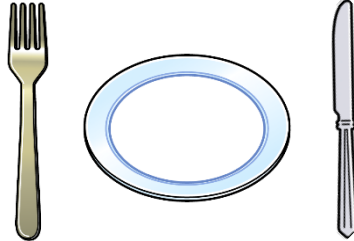


Why Not Participate in a Food Drive?
