

Please Make Use of the Inland Water & Flooding Hazard Maps



It is becoming difficult to prevent flood damage during heavy rains such as those during Typhoon 15 in September 2022 just by improving rivers and sewerage facilities. Please make yourself aware of estimated flood zones and flood depths and use this information in your daily provisions against heavy rain.

What is an Inland Water (内水, *nai sui*) Hazard Map?

A map that measures flooding from inland water in the case of the heaviest rainfall ever recorded in Shizuoka City (112mm rainfall per hour) and shows information such as flood zones, flood depth, and evacuation sites.

What is a Flooding (洪水, *kozui*) Hazard Map?

A map that predicts the flooding conditions when rivers above a certain size rise and break their embankments due to maximum scale rainfall, and shows information such as flood zones, flood depth, and evacuation sites.
