Banks transfers are a convenient method for ordinary payments (not available for those whose health insurance fees are deducted from their pension)

Please arrange a bank transfer once you have received your payment notice(納付通知書, *nofu tsuchisho*).

Applications for payment via bank transfer can be made at the service counter of your local Ward Office.

What to bring:

- Your payment notice or your health insurance card
- ID document that includes a photo of your face (drivers' license, My Number Card, etc.)
- Cash Card from an eligible financial institution (in your name or the name of the head of your household)

Eligible financial institutions:

Shizuoka Bank; Shimizu Bank; Seishin Shinkin Bank; Shizuoka Yaizu Shinkin Bank; JA Shizuokashi; JA Shimizu;
Japan Post Bank

If, due to exceptional circumstances, you cannot pay your health insurance fees:

There is a system for reducing or exempting your health insurance fees if you are receiving public or private benefits, or if your income has decreased due to disaster, accident, injury, or bankruptcy. Please inquire at the numbers below.

Regarding Application Period

Please note that the deadline for reductions and exemptions is 7 days before the relevant payment deadline.

(Or 7 days before each eligible pension payout date in the case of special collections (特別徴収, *tokubetsu choshu*)

***The deadline for term 1 health insurance fee reduction/exemption applications (regular collections) is Fri 23 June.** If you have any queries, please inquire before the deadline.
