

June is Landslide Disaster Prevention Month

Let's prevent landslide damage, together



Important Points: It's important to stay prepared and evacuate speedily

1. Check whether your home is in a landslide (special) warning zone (*dosha saigai (tokubetsu) keikai kuiki*) using the City's Disaster Prevention Map, the City and Prefectural websites, etc.
2. When it rains, be alert for heavy rain and landslide warnings.
3. If you detect signs of an imminent landslide (rumbling, falling stones, etc.) or feel like something is wrong, evacuate immediately.
