The City of Shizuoka aims to realize a multipurpose arena (that will bring a variety of entertainment and professional sports to Shizuoka City) and begin new development in the Higashi Shizuoka Area. This is expected to have a huge social impact, such as enhancing the appeal of the local area, promoting culture, and revitalizing the local economy. We plan to move ahead with the development of the arena through participation by private businesses and, if the expected financial burden to city government is deemed reasonable, as a collaborative project between the public and private sectors.
