

Assistance for Elementary and Junior High School Students



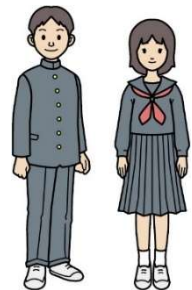

Student Financial Aid System (就学援助制度, *shugaku-enjo-seido*)

This system aids those facing financial difficulties in sending their children to public elementary or junior high schools by covering part of expenses such as school supplies and school meals.

Eligibility: Those to whom either 1 or 2 applies

1. Those receiving welfare benefits
2. Those facing economic hardship, with the total annual income of all cohabiting family members, minus social insurance premiums, falling below the criteria set by the city.



Financial Aid for Special Needs Education

To alleviate the economic burden on parents of children attending special support classes in municipal elementary and junior high schools, this aid covers part of school supply expenses (notebooks, pencils, etc.), commuting expenses (school bags, uniforms, etc.), and school meal costs. Receipts are required to receive aid for school supply and commuting expenses. If paying with a credit card, keep documents identifying the contract holder.

*For first-year students: Items purchased before enrollment (school bags, uniforms, etc.) may also be eligible for assistance, so please keep the receipts.
