

2. Afterschool Kids' Club

The "Afterschool Kids Club" (放課後受動クラブ, *hokago jido kurabu*) is an initiative that looks after elementary school children whose parents aren't at home after school due to work or other engagements, and nurtures them in a safe and wholesome environment.

*Depending on the number of applicants, entry may not be possible.

Open days: Mon-Sat (excluding public holidays and the year-end/new year period))

*Open during summer, winter, spring holidays, etc.

Open hours: From end of lessons to 19:00 on days when elementary school is open.

From 08:00 to 19:00 on days when elementary schools are closed.



Cost (Prices are for FY2024)

Aoi Ward, Suruga Ward, Shimizu Ward (Kambara Higashi and Yui):

9,500 JPY per month (14,000 JPY for August, 12,000 JPY for March)

Shimizu Ward (excluding Kambara Higashi and Yui):

7,500 JPY per month (12,000 JPY for August, 10,000 JPY for March)

Cost Reduction System

There is a cost reduction system in place for families with multiple siblings enrolled, and families with low income. See the city website for more information.

Deadlines for submission: Thurs 31 Oct 2024 for primary selections; Fri 31 Jan 2025 for secondary selections.
