The City Garbage Separation App Is Changing to “threeR”

Moving forward the city will be using “threeR” as its official garbage separation app. The app is packed with useful features such as a Garbage Collection Calendar and Separation Guide, helping to resolve a wide range of questions about garbage disposal. After installing the app and setting your residential area, you will receive notifications about garbage collection days and the latest information on garbage disposal.

Note: The current app, “Gomi Navi,” will no longer be available from 1 April.



Battery Collection Methods Are Changing

All used batteries will be collected as non-burnable or bulky waste through an advance application, with door-to-door collection.

Note: This does not apply to the six Abe areas of Aoi Ward.



Batteries That Can Be Collected

Place all batteries in a transparent bag and label it as shown below.

- Single-use batteries (button batteries, dry-cell batteries, coin batteries)
Write “電池入り” (^{でんちいり}denchi iri, Battery inside)
- Rechargeable batteries (lithium-ion batteries, nickel-cadmium batteries, nickel-metal hydride batteries)
Write your name, “不用” (^{ふよう}fuyo, Waste), and “充電池” (^{じゅうでんち}judenchi, Rechargeable batteries)

Note

- * Batteries are accepted regardless of recycling marks, swelling, or damage.
- * Applications can be made for even a single rechargeable battery.
- * Incorrect disposal of rechargeable batteries has caused fires in garbage collection trucks and waste treatment facilities nationwide. Please cooperate with proper garbage separation.

From April, only single-use batteries can be disposed of in small used electronics collection boxes.

Please Follow Garbage Disposal Rules

- Put garbage out at collection points by 8:30 on the morning of the collection day. Do not dispose of garbage the day before or at night.
Note: Collection times may change depending on the amount of garbage, traffic conditions, or the establishment of new collection points.
- Separate recyclable waste properly and put it out on recyclable waste collection days, following the rules set for your area.
