• System for Reducing or Exempting Insurance Premiums

If you are receiving public assistance or school expense support, or if your income has significantly decreased due to a disaster, illness, business bankruptcy, or similar circumstances, there is a system that allows for a reduction or exemption of insurance premiums.

- > Application Deadline
 - Up to 7 days before the nearest upcoming payment due date

(For special collection, up to 7 days before each pension payment date)

Note: Applications for insurance premium reductions/exemptions for fiscal year 2025 will begin on Friday, June 13. The application deadline for the first installment is Monday, June 23.

This Fiscal Year: Expanded Premium Reductions for Low-Income Households The income thresholds for households eligible for 20% and 50% premium reductions have been expanded.

Bank Account Transfer Is the Standard Payment Method for Regular Collection

Once you receive your payment notice, please complete the bank account transfer procedure. (This does not apply to those under special collection, where premiums are automatically deducted from pension payments.)
