The "Afterschool Kids Club" (放課後児童クラブ, hokago jido kurabu) is an initiative that looks after elementary school children whose parents aren't at home after school due to work or other engagements, and nurtures them in a safe and wholesome environment.

If the number of applicants exceeds capacity, some clubs may not be able to accept all children.

Mon-Sat (excluding public holidays and the year-end/new year period) Note: Clubs are also open during summer, winter, and spring breaks. Saturday operations vary by club.

On school days: After school until 18:00

• On non-school days: 8:00 to 18:00

Extended care available from 18:00 to 19:00

Usage Fees (As of FY2025, subject to change in FY2026)

Regular Monthly Fee: 7,500 yen

(August: 12,000 yen; March: 10,000 yen; Summer break period (21 July – 31 August): 14,600 yen)

• Extended Care Fee: 100 yen per use (maximum 1,000 yen per month)

Deadlines:

First round: Fri 31 October

Second round: Sat 31 January (2026)

Applications for May enrollment and beyond will be accepted starting in February.
