
Note: If you do not receive the notification letter by the end of December, please contact us.

The school your child will attend is determined by your residential school district. However, if certain requirements are met, it may be possible to change the designated school.

If you wish to request a change, for new first-year elementary school students, advance applications are accepted by phone from November. Please contact the Student Support Division.

For new first-year junior high school students, the school will contact you from mid-November onward. For the enrollment of non-Japanese children, please contact the Student Support Division.

If your child will attend a school other than a municipal school in Shizuoka City, please discard the notification.

Applications for School Expense Assistance (Enrollment Preparation Grant) Are Now Open

For parents and guardians who have difficulty covering school-related expenses for financial reasons, an enrollment preparation grant will be provided before enrollment (in February next year). For details, please contact the elementary or junior high school your child will attend, or the Student Support Division.

Eligible: Households with children scheduled to enter a public elementary or junior high school in April next year, and whose income is below the city's certification criteria

Application forms: Available at each elementary and junior high school office or distributed at the school-entry health checkup

If your child is a sixth-grade elementary school student who has already been certified as eligible for school expense assistance (quasi-protected), no further procedures are necessary.
