# **Drunk Driving is a Serious Crime**

Although stricter penalties have helped reduce accidents caused by drunk driving in recent years, tragic incidents still occur. The year-end season brings more opportunities to drink alcohol. Providing alcohol to drivers, encouraging them to drink, or riding in a vehicle driven by someone who has been drinking are all punishable offenses.





If you drink, don't drive. If you drive, don't drink.

### Blue Ticket System for Bicycle Traffic Violations

Due to revisions to the Road Traffic Act, the Traffic Violation Notification System (Blue Ticket) will be introduced starting 1 April 2026. It applies to traffic violations committed by bicycle riders aged 16 and older. For details, please visit the city website.

#### **Main Violations and Penalty Amounts:**

- Using a mobile phone while riding (distracted riding): ¥12,000
- Ignoring traffic signals: ¥6,000
- Riding on the right side of the roadway: ¥6,000
- Failure to stop at a stop sign: ¥5,000
- Riding without lights: ¥5,000
- Riding side by side: ¥3,000
