Please put your garbage in the collection area by 8:30AM

Actual collection time varies due to factors such as traffic conditions and amount of garbage, but please put out your garbage in the designated area by 8:30AM on your neighborhood's collection day.

*Please refrain from putting out garbage on the day before collection, or during the night.

Please use up spray cans before disposal

Make sure spray cans are completely empty (do not make a hole in them), and separate them from other cans before disposing them on the monthly recycling day according to the rules for your neighborhood. See the guidebook for more information.
