Accepting Applications for Enrollment Aid through the Student Financial Aid System



Enrollment aid (入学準備金, *nyugaku-junbikin*) is available to families with children entering public elementary or junior high school in April, who find it financially difficult to cover the associated costs (the City has specific criteria). This aid will be paid to eligible families in February, before enrollment. Application is not required by parents of 6th grade elementary school students who are already approved as "equivalent to requiring public assistance" (準要保護, *jun-yohogo*) under the student financial support system (就学援助, *shugaku-enjo*).

Zero Interest Student Loans Available to Single-Parent Households

Candidates: Single-parent households with a child enrolled or scheduled to enroll in high school or university, that are having difficulty paying enrollment fees, tuition, etc.

Repayment Period: The period from 6 months after graduation to approximately twice the length of the loan period (maximum 20 years).

*In principle, application must be made by the parent. Inquire for details regarding application method, maximum loan amount, etc.
