## 3. Heatstroke Alerts and Preventive Measures

Heat-related illnesses can be serious. To help protect residents, two alert levels are used to indicate the risk of heatstroke. When either alert is issued, please take immediate precautions.

## Heatstroke Alert

Issued via the City's official LINE and X accounts when temperatures are "dangerously hot", with an elevated risk of heatstroke.

## **Special Heatstroke Alert**

A level above the Heatstroke Warning Alert, issued via the City's official LINE and X accounts, and over the citywide loudspeakers when the risk of heatstroke is extremely high.

## What to Do When an Alert Is Issued

- Drink water and replenish salt frequently.
- Use umbrellas or hats for sun protection.
- Use a "cooling shelter"

To help residents beat the heat, municipal facilities such as libraries and lifelong learning centers have been designated as "cooling shelters." See the City website for a list of facilities and opening hours. www.city.shizuoka.lg.jp/s2835/s003181.html
