The City of Shizuoka provides condolence payments to victims of crime and their families, as well as subsiding the cost of things such as housework and nursing care.

*The above support applies to crime that occurred on or after 1 April 2024.

Eligibility Criteria:

The victim must have been a Shizuoka City resident at the point the crime occurred. *This includes those who were not on the residents' register but were, in fact, residing in the city at the time.

Applicable Crimes:

Acts constituting a crime that harms the life or body of another. *Must be objectively verifiable though such things as reports submitted to the police.

Deadline For Applications: Within one year of the day the crime occurred.

 <u>Condolence payment to the family of the deceased:</u> 300,000 JPY <u>Condolence payment in the case of serious injury or illness:</u> 100,000 JPY *When the doctor-prescribed recovery period is one month or longer. <u>Condolence payment to victims of sexual crimes (rape and other crimes):</u> 100,000 JPY 	 <u>Support payment for daily life:</u> Max. 100,000 JPY *The cost of housework, food delivery, nursing care, and childcare services. <u>Support payment for moving house:</u> Max. 200,000 JPY
