The Shizuoka Railway Company (commonly known as Shizutetsu) has played a leading role in Shizuoka City's local transport industry. Its history began in the Meiji period, and it has continued to evolve alongside a modernizing Japan. We follow the journey of the Shizuoka Railway Company, exploring the history of Shizuoka City during the social upheaval of Japan's rapid economic growth period.

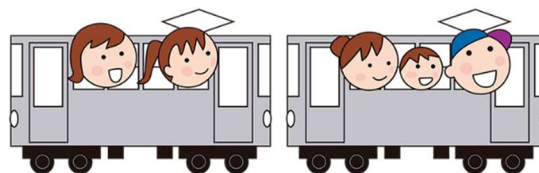
Shizuoka History Guided Walking Tours
