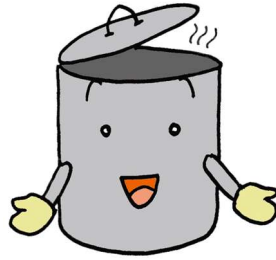


School Lunch Fees to be Included in Public Accounts



Shizuoka City's School Lunch
Character: Shokkan-kun

Up until now, school lunch fees were collected by each school, but from FY2025 they will be collected and managed by the city.

Applicable Persons: Parents of children attending municipal elementary and junior high schools.

Collection Period: Ten times a year, from May.

What Does This Mean?

School lunch fees collected from parents will be included in the city's general accounts as income, and the cost of things like ingredients will be included as expenses.

What are the Benefits?

Including school lunch fees in city budget will lead to more **precise accounting and management of funds**.

Securing school lunch fees with the city budget will lead to a **stable supply of school lunches** without affecting price, quality, or quantity.

Monthly Amount to Be Withdrawn

Elementary School: $280 \text{ JPY} \times 180 \text{ meals} \div 10 \text{ payments} = 5040 \text{ JPY}$

Junior High School: $325 \text{ JPY} \times 180 \text{ meals} \div 10 \text{ payments} = 5850 \text{ JPY}$

*In the case of 180 per year. If the actual number of meals differs, adjustments will be made to the tenth payment.
