June is Landslide Disaster Prevention Month

Let's prevent landslide damage, together.

Routine preparation by individual residents is a key factor in minimizing damage from landslides. Let's make sure we're all prepared and ready for a speedy evacuation.

Three Important Points:

- Check whether your home is in a yellow landslide warning zone (土砂災害警戒区域, dosha saigai keikai kuiki) or red landslide special warning zone (土砂災害特別警戒区域, dosha saigai tokubetsu keikai kuiki) using a disaster prevention map. (https://www2.wagmap.jp/shizuoka-hazard-sp/)
- 2. When it rains, be alert for heavy rain and landslide warnings.
- If you detect signs of an imminent landslide (rumbling, falling stones, etc.) or feel like something is wrong, evacuate immediately.



Yellow Zones: Areas with a risk of damage from landslides. Red Zones: Areas with a risk of buildings collapsing, and danger to inhabitants.
