Landslides: "Disaster Prevention Map" (防災マップ, bosai mappu)

River Flooding: "River Flooding Evacuation Map" (洪水ひなん地図, kozui hinan chizu) Inland Flooding: "Flooding Evacuation Map" (浸水ひなん地図, shinsui hinan chizu)



If there is a risk of disaster, please evacuate to a friend's house, a local gathering place, or an Emergency Wind and Flood Damage Evacuation Area (https://www.city.shizuoka.lg.jp/s4268/s000067.html).

If there is no danger of your house collapsing, being flooded, or being washed away, you can wait at home until it is safe. This is called "home evacuation". Make sure to prepare evacuation supplies in advance.



The colored-in areas are areas with a high level of danger from disasters. Please note that even areas that are not colored in can be affected by disasters, so please evacuate if necessary.
