*Pre-school-age children must be accompanied by a parent.

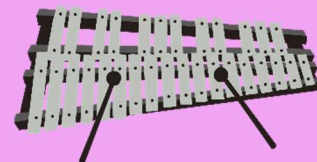
- **Make Your Own Instrument (Balloon Drum) Workshop:**
