

# Before you disembark the ship



#### Free shuttle bus

Once you dock into Shimizu Port and disembark the ship, you will see the Shimizu Marine Terminal before you. If you plan to head into the central area of Shimizu, catching the free shuttle bus which leaves from outside the Shopping Mall [S-Pulse Dream Plaza] (%1), adjacent to the Marine Terminal would be most convenient. This will take you to JR Shimizu station in only 10 minutes (refer to the route on the back of this MAP).



If you wish to do some shopping, you can find a currency exchange office in the Shimizu Marine Terminal (%2). It is also possible to change currency at a bank, however, they are only open between 9am through 3pm on weekdays. It is also possible to withdraw Japanese currency through overseas cashing services from a cash card that was issued in your home country at an ATM machine which have [PLUS] [Cirrus] marks at convenience stores.


