


# 府中宿 広域マップ Fuchu-shuku Area Map



**Wakamiya-Hachimangū (Shrine)**  
This shrine is home to a camphor tree which is more than a thousand years old.

**Shizuoka Sengen-jinja (Shrine)**  
It holds 26 buildings that are designated as national important cultural properties.

**Cha-machi: Tea District**  
There are more than a hundred professional tea masters here.

**Remains of Jippensha Ikku's birthplace**  
Jippensha was the author of *Footing it along the Tōkaidō*, a comic picaresque novel.

**Remains of Nishi-mitsuke**

**Remains of Sunpu Oyaku-en**  
A medicinal-herb garden maintained by Ieyasu, who was very interested in health and wellness.

**Kiyomizu-dera (Temple)**  
This temple was built at the bequest of a member of the Imagawa clan. The temple is said to have been named for its view, which is similar to that of Kiyomizu-dera in Kyoto. It is also closely related to Lord Ieyasu.

**Keyō-in (Temple)**  
This temple is centered around the tomb of Keyō-in, the grandmother of Tokugawa Ieyasu.

**Remains of Higashi-mitsuke**  
There used to be a fence on top of the stone wall and a watchman stationed there.



**Hōdai-in (Temple)**  
A family temple of Saigō-no-tsuboné (O-Ai-no-kata), a concubine of Ieyasu and a mother of Hidetada, the second Shōgun.

**浮月楼 Fugetsu-rō**  
This is where the Sunpu Daikan residence was located during the Edo period and where Prince Yoshinobu Tokugawa lived for more than 20 years during the Meiji period (1868-1912).

**宝泰寺 Hōtai-ji (Temple)**  
One of the three Suruga temples. The temple served as a resting and lodging facility for Korean and Ryukyuan envoys.

**Kunō-kaidō (Highway)**  
It is said that feudal lords (Daimyō) regularly visited Keyō-in (Temple) and Kunō-zan Tōshōgū (Shrine) along the Kunō-kaidō and Tōkaidō amidst their annual travels to and from Edo (Tokyo).
